Pool Rules

2013

All rules listed here are supplemental to any posted rules at the pool facility; some regulations are imposed by the NC Department of Environmental and Natural Resources, and violation could result in immediate shut down of the facility.

SAFETY

1. Safety is first and utmost, and should be every homeowner's responsibility.
2. Pool hours are 6:00 am – 9:00 pm daily.
3. Absolutely NO GLASS of any kind allowed within the pool area.
4. The pool shall be considered closed at the sound of thunder or the sight of lightening.
5. No skateboards, roller blades, scooters, bicycles, or any object with wheels permitted within the gated pool area.
6. Pool furniture is NOT allowed in the pool at any time, for any reason.
7. No swimming alone. (per NC Health Department)
8. No running, pushing, fighting, profanity, or unruly behavior that may be deemed unsafe.
9. No diving into the pool at any time due to shallow water.

HEALTH & CLEANLINESS

1. Babies and children not potty trained must wear swim pants (not regular diapers) under bathing suits.
2. Caution your children to use the toilet facilities provided in the pool area.
3. Feces in the pool may cause an outbreak of E-coli. Any incidents must be reported immediately to a committee member or the management company. Depending on the circumstances, the pool may need to be closed for a period of time for chemical adjustment.
4. Deposit your trash in the trash receptacles provided within the pool area, and clean the area you occupied. Close umbrellas if you have opened them.
5. No smoking in the pool area.
6. Absolutely no pets permitted in the gated pool area.
7. No food, liquids, gum, or debris allowed in the pool.

CHILDREN

1. All Children under 14 are required to be accompanied at all times in the gated pool area by his or her own parent or guardian or a homeowner who will be directly responsible for them. All children are solely the responsibility of their parents.
2. Children 14 or older are allowed entry to the pool without a parent if they are able to act responsibly.

GUESTS

1. ONLY homeowners and their guests are permitted in the pool area. Homeowners will be held responsible for all actions of their guests at ALL times.

2. The homeowner is responsible for his/her family and guests and may be charged for property damage, should there be any.

OTHER

1. Pool phone is for emergency use only.
2. Pool furniture is not to be removed from the gated pool area.
3. Remove all personal toys or flotation devices from the pool when not in use and upon leaving.
4. When playing music, be considerate of others and keep the volume at a level that will be heard by you and your group only.
5. Owners are expected to clean up after themselves in the restrooms.
6. Everyone should make sure they are not dripping wet when entering the restroom area to prevent accidents. The floors are extremely slippery when wet.
7. The pool may not be closed to any homeowner for a private, exclusive party at any time.

The Cannon Crossing Pool Committee and the HOA request that all members of Cannon Crossing Community share in the responsibility of enforcing these rules and regulations.

The Cannon Crossing Pool Committee and the HOA reserve the right to change, delete, and/or add to the above listed rules as the need arises, with the approval of the Board of Directors.
